These hymn tune arrangements, in four-part harmony, are intended for performance by a large variety of ensembles. The parts provided are not intended for specific instruments, but enough transpositions are included to cover most common instruments. The delegation of parts to instruments is left to the discretion of the musical director.

A full list of the parts can be found on the next page.

Accompaniment parts for Organ (3 stave) and Piano (2 stave) are included. It should be noted that the piano parts is an exact replication of the main four parts. Consequently, there will be occasions - especially between the Tenor and Bass parts - where intervals of greater than an octave occur. In these instances, the pianist is encouraged to play *ad libitum*, either moving the bass part up an octave, or omitting the tenor note.

The arrangements are, in general, those found in popular hymn books such as the New English Hymnal, Hymns Ancient & Modern and Mission Praise, and are now in the public domain. The following arrangements are ©2006 Matt Kingston:
